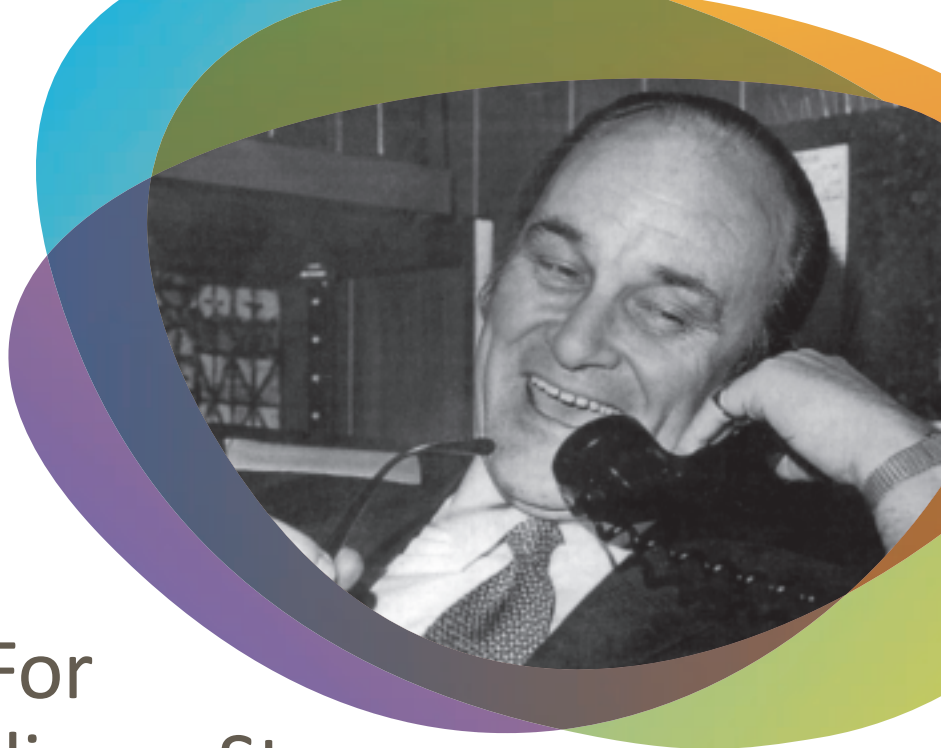


The Leslie Yeo Award for Volunteerism

2012 Call for Nominations

The Board of Governors of AFBS is calling for nominations for the 2012 Leslie Yeo Award for Volunteerism to find that one story. It is an opportunity for you to ensure that an individual you know is finally acknowledged for an unselfish contribution or contributions that may have occurred behind the scenes.

The Award

The Leslie Yeo Award consists of a \$5,000.00 cash award to the recipient whose story of volunteerism should be recognized. Leslie's career in theatre, television and film spanned nearly six decades. In addition to his love of the performing arts, Leslie had a profound respect for people and their capacity to give back, which led him to become a founding father of AFBS.

Eligibility

To be eligible to receive this award, the Member first must be nominated, and he or she must be either a current or past Member of Actra Fraternal Benefit Society. Most importantly, the Member must have made an exceptional, non-financial, voluntary contribution to the Canadian Artistic Community.

You may also fax toll-free to 1-888-804-8929. All nomination and supporting documents must be received at AFBS by 5:00 p.m. EST, February 1, 2012.

The Process

A Member may nominate any current or past Member, including himself or herself, for consideration by the Donations Committee of Actra Fraternal Benefit Society. All nominations must be provided in writing, addressed to the Chair of the Donations Committee, and must include the name and contact information of the person nominated; the name and contact information of the nominator; the rationale for the nomination; and a minimum of two additional letters in support of the person nominated.

The Donations Committee of Actra Fraternal Benefit Society will make a recommendation to the Board of Governors for the recipient of the Leslie Yeo Award for Volunteerism 2012, at the Society's February 2012 Board of Governors meeting. The final decision of the winner will rest exclusively with the Board of Governors of AFBS.

Since a nomination cannot be altered once they have been submitted to the Society, please take the time to review it thoroughly. The Donations Committee makes its decision based on the content of the nomination, letters of support, and does not review additional materials.

The recipient of the award will be contacted and the award presented at the AFBS Annual General Meeting in May/June. At that event and on our website, you'll meet the Member whose life has made a difference.
